Incorrect or out of phase camshaft timing can result in contact between the valve head and the piston crown causing damage to the engine.

Safety

Ensure that Health and Safety, local authority and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using tools. **DO NOT** use tools if there is any sign of damage Maintain tools in good and clean condition for best and safest performance. Ensure that a vehicle which has been jacked up is adequately supported with axle stands. Wear approved eye protection. Account for all tools, locking bolts, pins and parts being used and do not leave them in or near the engine.
